Dear Parents and
Guardians,

Reading: This month, we will start our new unit on Non-Fiction reading clubs. Please continue to push your children at home using the supports sent in the homework folders.

Talk with them while they are reading about the main topic and details. Have them teach you about what they are reading. Encourage them to use text features to help them read tricky words and remind them to stay curious and ask questions about their topics.

Writing: During this month, we will write Science Lab Reports. We will perform experiments and record our observations. Help your child at home by asking questions like, "If I put this water over the stove, what will happen to it?" Say: "I predict it will boil." This is testing out your question, making a hypothesis, and observing your results. Then write about what was learned.

Math: This month we are going to learn about measurement. Encourage your child to measure things around the house. Not just with a ruler or tape measure, but use objects like spoons and shoes to see a different unit of measurement.

Then record your observations.

Social Studies: We are learning about the government and its laws.

Science: We are learning about plants.
