Principal Updates:

- RTI program started for students struggling in phonics with additional support in reading/ writing.
- We will be adding more RTI programs for both testing and non-testing grades.
- We have departmentalized reading, writing, math and ss/science literacy, it is working well.
- Teachers have been working closely with Maryann Cucchiara. This work supports language development for all students. Ms. Rosenbaum works closely with MaryAnn to support teachers.
- A few teachers have developed their work so much with Maryann Cucchiara to the point that it positively impacted their instruction and their students, so impressively, that Maryann and the Council of Great City Schools filmed their planning and their classes as part of their project to strengthen instruction and learning across the United States.

CEP Goal #4:

- This is the simplest goal.
- Talks about school leadership- who makes decisions for the school and if we do it with the whole school body.
- Every Monday the staff participates in professional learning.
- Over the course of 3 months, teachers met in inquiry teams, which met a total of about 7 times. This is owned/ lead by everybody (teachers/ paraprofessionals) 90% of the time.
- The decisions are also made by the (PLC)- Professional learning committee
- On Monday 2/13, inquiry teams are sharing their findings and best practices. Throughout inquiry, teachers and paraprofessionals looked at student data and decided changes according to the data.
- Our upcoming professional Mondays will include more planning time.
- We look at what adjustments can we make to help all the students (students with an IEP, ENL, Gen-ed). There is targeted small group work going on all the time in classrooms.
- In the action plan for the CEP goal, the first and second part is the same. We will be adjusting the Professional learning Monday's to 3 Monday's focusing on writing, reading and math by looking at data and it will still be teacher led. On the 4th Monday, teachers will collaborate vertically to discuss trends. Teachers will still be using protocols to look at student data. We will adjust the action plan with our professional Monday.

Title 1: Led by J.D Rose title one Rep

- The parent advisory committee had a meeting (there was 16 in attendance, including 4 members on the committee).
- They met to vote on how to spend the \$5,000. The \$5,000 has to be spent on parent workshops.
- Topic that had the most votes was computer literacy classes for parents.
- Sonya was there and said they can use some of the money for meeting refreshments.
- J.D Rose came to propose activities and for the SLT to propose a plan. The activities will be presented to the next PTA meeting.
- Other suggestions- literacy, math workshops.

- They want to have flexible time frames for working/ non-working parents.
- Different sessions for different levels of computer levels.
- SLT voted that they are in favor of the computer literacy workshop from outside vendors or programs for computer literacy workshops.

Reading Data:

- Broken down by grade based on the benchmark.
- Supports given in springtime will focus on ELL students.
- Teachers make action plans for each student.

Finalize by- laws- Rules for non-members:

"Only School Leadership Team (SLT) members can present and comment during the SLT meetings.
