***Review of CEP Goal #3- Collaborative Teachers

- By June 2018, all teachers will participate in vertical/horizontal teams to revise instructional structures and plans to increase the percentage of students scoring at and above bench marks.
- During the 2015-2016 year, we received “well-developed” for teaching teams. In 2016-2017 we received a rating of “developing.” Feedback indicated we needed to put data results into action.
- Our annual goal addresses those needs.
- Action Plan
 - Vertical Teams- K-5
 - Horizontal Teams- K-5
 - Cycles of team meetings
 - Google Drive
 - Parents will have access to video support and workshops in English, Spanish and Bengali.
- Family Engagement
 - Workshops
 - Video support
 - Communication
- Budget
 - Tech Support
 - Google Drive (per session funds)
 - PDs
 - Funds allocated to replenish guided reading books- Teachers can request it
 - Horizontal and Vertical Teams
 - Teams have limited time to delve into specific issues week after week to build consistency. Trying to find time for PDs, team meetings, breakfast in the classroom, etc. is challenging.
 - Team structure is better this year. Google Drive has helped.
- Quality Review is all about impact and structure resulting in better student performance

- Administrators review data to see what is happening and why and use data to plan/adjust instruction.
- Review of interim data in reading from October to January showed that students at the highest reading benchmark (level 4) showed a significant dip. This doesn't necessarily mean they regressed. One possible implication could be they are assessed less often than struggling students
- This data is monitored, analyzed and used to plan for instruction
